Honesty and truth are valued. Dishonesty distorts and damages.
Examples of innocent, neutral, and harmful:

BIBLE has about 152 occurrences of 15 English words. Deception as old as Eden in Genesis 3. In NT, the phrase “(do) not be deceived” appear 5 times. Ancient warning with modern applications.

1. False Christs Luke 21:8(Matt. 24:5,23-25; Mark 13:6, 21-23)

- Jesus called a ‘deceiver’ in John 7:12 and Matt. 27:63-64
- Satan called a ‘deceiver’ in Rev. 12:9; 20:3,8,10 Which is phony?

2. Failure To Reach the Kingdom 1 Cor. 6:9-10

- How we live determines where we go. Tendencies to minimize, rationalize, redefine, refine, or defend sins do not change God’s Word. Another deception: Our sins forfeit God’s forgiveness.

3. Friends That Corrupt 1 Cor. 15:33

- Context of a ‘this-life-is-all-there-is’ worldview. Pleasure principle
- Friends are a HUGE part of life, but not all are helpful or encouraging in the right ways. Seek friends helping you seek God!

4. Fleshly Harvests Gal. 6:7

- Carnal and spiritual are always at war. Devil wants us to play both sides. Compromise with the flesh = contempt for the Father!

5. Foundation of Temptation James 1:16

- From God? No From Satan? Yes, but ultimately me!
- James 1:17-18 - God is, God is Good, God is giving good gifts!
