MEMORY VERSE OF THE WEEK

Ephesians 4:2

"Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love."

DIVE IN

Patience is the ability to calmly wait for something you want or put up with pain or trouble without getting upset or angry. Patience is definitely not a skill you are born with, and it can be very difficult to learn. You will practice patience every day of your life in one way or another, whether you are waiting in line or dealing with an annoying brother or sister who just won't leave you alone!

Why does God want us to be patient? First, God wants us to trust in Him and His plan. Even when we don't understand why life doesn't always go our way.
