- Lottie Williams, Jenny Rominger's mother. Her glucose & liver enzymes need to go down so she may continue chemo treatment.

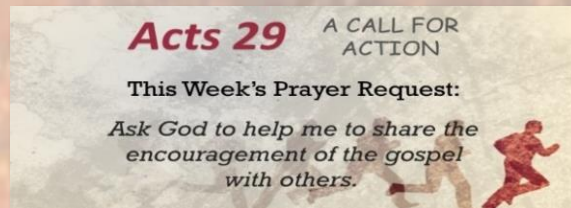

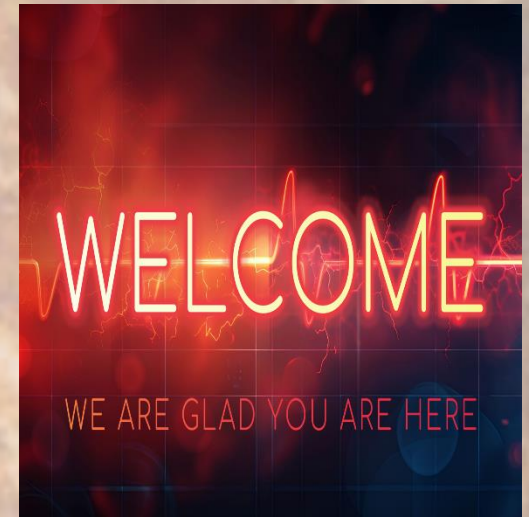
